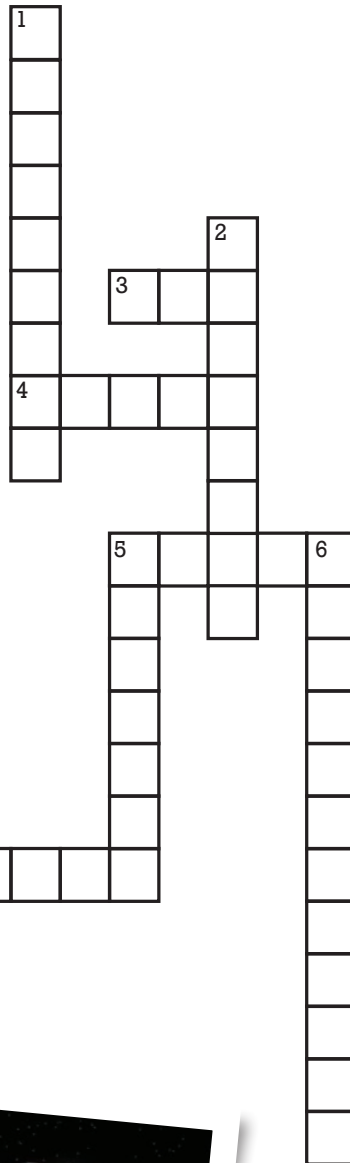
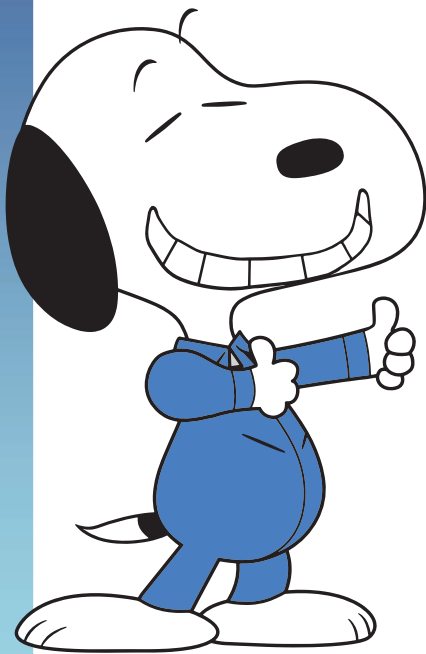


# Happy Anniversary, Space Station!

Are you a space expert? Fill in the crossword below to test your knowledge of the International Space Station!

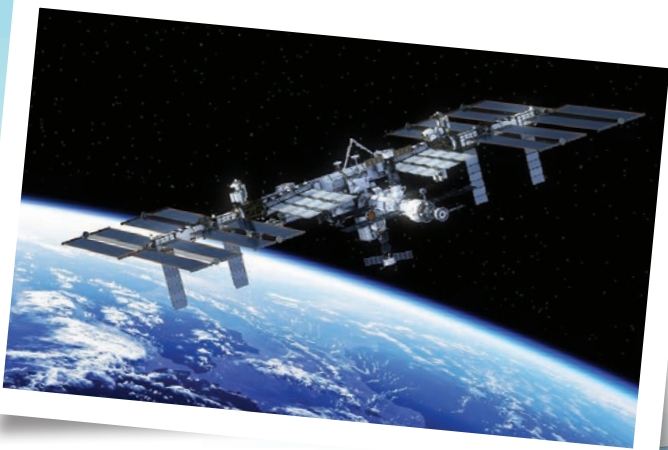
