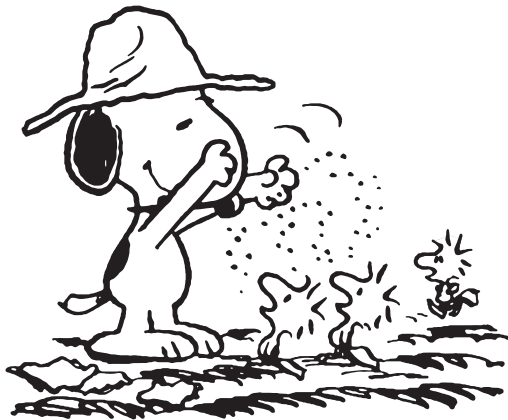

MAKE YOUR BIRD FEEDER

Instructions:

- To make your bird feeder you will need:
 - Pine cones OR empty toilet paper rolls
 - Peanut butter
 - Bird seed
 - String
 - Scissors
 - Pan or baking sheet
- The first step is to go on a nature walk and find a few pine cones that have fallen off the trees (don't pick the pine cones off the trees!). If you don't live near a tree with pine cones, you can use an empty toilet paper or paper towel roll.
- Next, cut and tie a 7-10 inch piece of string to the tip of the pine cone. If you are using a toilet paper tube, you can thread the string through the tube and tie the two ends together.
- The next step is best to do outside as it might get messy! First, spread peanut butter all over your pine cone or tube. Make sure it is a thick layer and all over!
- Next, pour the birdseed into your pan or baking sheet. Then, roll the pine cone in the bird seed so the seeds stick to the peanut butter and is totally covered.
- Find a tree to hang your feeder on and over the next couple days, keep an eye on your bird feeder to see what kind of creatures enjoy your treat!
